

RESOLUTION 2000-3

OF THE

SOUTHWEST KANSAS GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

Whereas, K.S.A. 82a-1028. District Powers; home office. Provides, in part, that:


Every groundwater management district organized under this act shall be a body politic and corporate and shall have the power to:

- (a) adopt a seal; and
- (b) sue and be sued in its corporate name; and
- (c) rent space, maintain and equip an office, and pay other administrative expenses; and
- (d) employ such legal, engineering, technical, and clerical services as may be deemed necessary by the board; and
- (n) adopt, amend, promulgate, and enforce by suitable action, administrative or otherwise, reasonable standards and policies relating to the conservation and management of groundwater within the district which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this act or Article 7 of Chapter 82a of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and all acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; and
- (q) select a residence or home office for the groundwater management district which shall be at a place in a county in which the district or any part thereof is located and may be either within or without the boundaries of the district. The board shall designate the county in which the residence or home office is located as the official county for the filing of all official acts and assessments; and


