

RESOLUTION

Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3
Policy on Depletion Calculation Evaluations

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 have adopted a Management Program on July 23, 1976 and a Revised Management Program on July 12, 1978 and a Revised Management Program II on November 12, 1980, which includes a provision to review Applications for Permit to Appropriate Water for Beneficial Use according to a Depletion Criteria outlined in said plan and make recommendations to the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, Kansas State Board of Agriculture, and

WHEREAS, the Division of Water Resources describes the locations of wells on permits in ten (10) acre tracts, and


WHEREAS, it has been an administrative procedure of the Division of Water Resources to approve a point of diversion if it is within 300 feet of the indicated location in the application and it is in the same ten (10) acre tract, and

WHEREAS, there has developed a need for Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 to develop an administrative procedure in this regard.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District No. 3 make their recommendations on Depletion Calculation Evaluations pursuant to K.S.A. 82A 1028(n).

The center of a standard legal ten (10) acre tract will be the unit of consideration for depletion calculations and where the land is described by lots they shall be divided into ten (10) acre tracts and the center of any remaining portions thereof will be the unit of consideration for the depletion calculations.
