whereas consistency in the administration of policies and standards, and the Rules & Regulations, is mandatory for effective regulation and to maintain the creditability of the District;

to waive Standards and Policies, or the Rules & Regulations, shall be heard using the following guidelines:

 (a) all applications eligible for consideration must first be assigned an appropriation number by the Division of Water Resources;

(b) before an appeal may be made to the Board of Directors, a recommendation, pursuant to a request from the Division of Water Resources, must be made by District staff;

(c) the applicant shall request the issue be placed on the meeting Agenda prior to the meeting;

(d) the applicant, or representative, must be present or the Board of Directors may not consider the appeal;

(e) when new information is presented, or statements of fact are made, which is not documented or cannot be immediately verified, it shall be the policy of the Board of Directors to take the matter under advisement until the next meeting, in order to allow the staff to further investigate the information:

(f) if additional information; is needed to make a decision, if additional information is needed to make a decision, the Board of Directors may take the matter under advisement until the next meeting and request the staff, and or, the applicant to supply the information;
