

**RESOLUTION 93-12**

**OF THE**

**SOUTHWEST KANSAS GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS, K.S.A. 82a-1028. District Powers; home office. provides, in part, that:**

**Every groundwater management district organized under this act shall be a body politic and corporate and shall have the power to:**


- (d) employ such legal, engineering, technical, and clerical services as may be deemed necessary by the board; and**
- (n) adopt, amend, promulgate, and enforce by suitable action, administrative or otherwise, reasonable standards and policies relating to the conservation and management of groundwater within the District which are not consistent with the provisions of this act or Article 7 of Chapter 82a of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and all acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; and**


**WHEREAS, the Directors have found the establishment and recordation of by-laws, standards, policies, and procedures regarding the District's administrative functions to be necessary, desirable, advantageous, and in the public interest; and**

**WHEREAS, the Directors have caused the referenced "Administrative Programs 1994" to be compiled in this regard and for this purpose; then**

**THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Southwest Kansas Groundwater Management District that, by instrument of this resolution, the aforementioned "Administrative Programs 1994" be adopted as the District's official by-laws, standards, policies, and procedures required to fulfill the administrative functions of the Board, its staff, and associated constituents as provided for in the Groundwater Management District Act and related governing articles.**
